Alan Charles Melton, age 75, of Strawberry Plains, TN, went home to be with our Lord on Friday, August 1, 2025. Alan was born on August 29, 1949, in a one-room log cabin in Morgan County, TN, to Mary Ellen and Floyd Leo Melton. Alan enlisted in the Army in June of 1968. He served for three years in Germany and left as an acting buck sergeant (E-5). He retired from the US Postal Service but continued his lifelong passion as a flight instructor at the Sky Ranch. He married Donna Arlene White in May of 1992 and they brought together a blended family that grew to include 8 children and 18 grandchildren. Alan enjoyed flying and spending time on the lake, camping, and working in his garage. Alan was preceded in death by his parents, Floyd and Mary Melton; brother, Jeffrey Melton, and grandson, John Ethan Tipton. He is survived by his loving wife, Donna; children, Dustin Melton (Jennifer), Andrea Eley, Crystal Tipton (John), Brandy Roberts (Jeff), Amber Boyer (Clint), McKayla Woods (Lucas), Caleb, and Tristan Melton; a host of grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

The family will receive friends on Monday, August 11th, from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM at First Baptist Church of Strawberry Plains, with the funeral to follow with Pastor Tony Hayes officiating. 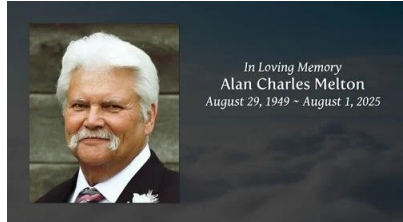
