



## Charles Kenneth Gray

January 29, 1933 - May 10, 2015

Charles Kenneth Gray, 82, of Jefferson City, passed away Sunday, May 10, 2015. He enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 1950 and fought in Korea from 1951 to 1954. After returning stateside, he married Georgia Helen Taylor on June 5th 1954 and honorably discharged from the Marine Corps June 15, 1954. He retired from Bell South Phone Company after 38 years. Both Charles and Helen Gray were active members of Glenmore Chapter of APTA in Jefferson City. He was a Sunday School teacher at George Street United Methodist Church while both of his boys were growing up. He became an active member at First Baptist Church of Jefferson City during his daughter's youth. He was an active member of Mossy Creek Masonic Lodge #353. Later in life, Charles became extremely active in Veterans' Affairs thru the American Legion Post #2 and the Marine Corps League; as well as enjoyed driving a school bus for Jefferson County Schools, for 15 years.
