Dallas M. Hammer, age 78, of New Market, TN went to be with the Lord December 30, 2016, at UT Medical Center after a lengthy battle with cancer, which he fought with grace and dignity. Dallas was a member of Rocky Valley Baptist Church, having served as Chairman of Deacons for many years, Men's Sunday School class teacher, treasurer of the Building Committee and spent many hours rebuilding the church building after it burned in 1998.
