



## Gene Rogers

October 5, 1940 - July 12, 2018

Gene Rogers, 77, of New Market, passed away on Thursday, July 12, 2018. He was a member of New Market Baptist Church. He started law enforcement in 1965 in Polk County, Florida and served with various police departments and sheriff offices. He retired from the U.S. Marshal service in Knoxville, TN. After retiring, Gene became the first Chief of Police for the City of New Market. For the last 10 years, Gene continued to serve the community as the New Market City Judge and Magistrate.

He was preceded in death by his father, Lyman Frazier Rogers; mother, Lois Lyles; step-father, Robert Lyles; and infant son, Frazier Webster Rogers. 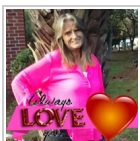
