



## George W. Cameron

March 25, 1921 - May 1, 2017

George W. Cameron, 96, of New Market, passed away Monday, May 1, 2017 at his home.

George grew up in Rutledge, TN. He was a World War II Army Veteran, serving in Normandy, Northern France, Germany and Central Europe. As a Sergeant with A Company 852nd Engineer Aviation Battalion, he received a "Theatre Ribbon" with 4 bronze stars, a Good Conduct Medal, and a Bronze Star Medal.

After the war, George worked for Ruth Brothers Construction and Charles B. Stephens Construction. In the early sixties, he worked for the McDowell Contractors as a Field Superintendent. Later he went to work for Brown Brothers Construction as a Field Superintendent, retiring in his early seventies. George enjoyed retirement on his farm, raising Black Angus cattle and driving his tractor.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Anna Mae; and daughter-in-law, Regina Cameron.

He is survived by sons, Allen Cameron, Danny (Janella) Cameron, and Ricky Cameron; grandsons, Eric (Heather) Cameron, Lucas and Ben Cameron; granddaughter, Chris (Keith) Lawson; great-grandchildren, Brycen and Trystan Cameron, Hunter and Conner Lawson; several nieces and nephews.
