



George Ellis "Chip" Hodgson

November 9, 1946 - January 22, 2016

George Ellis (Chip) Hodgson, age 69, passed away January 22nd peacefully at his home in New Market, surrounded by his family.

He was a 1964 graduate of Jefferson High School. He then volunteered for the military and served in several locations in the USA and in Vietnam. He later attended Embry Riddle Aeronautical Institute in Daytona, Florida, where he graduated in 1970 with a degree in Aircraft Maintenance Management. He was the owner of Hodgson Enterprises, a grading and hauling business, for 39 years. One of his greatest pleasures was restoring classic cars.
