He also attended Carolina State University. Chap or RG as he was known to many was a simple man who was so full of life and loved to laugh and cut up. He believed in the importance of an education and was a very giving man who always supported the Baptist Children’s Home of Sevierville and Kingswood School of Grainger County. He cared greatly about children and was an avid animal lover. Ralph served on the Jefferson County School Board and loved being a volunteer member of the New Market Fire Department. He served our country for a total of 30 years, 15 years in the Army and 15 years in the Air Force. During this time he was a trained medic and firefighter having spent many years at McGhee Tyson Airbase as an officer.
